Commodity EXIM Report DGCI&S, ITJ Division

- 1. The weekly EXIM Report published by ITJ Division of DGCI&S, Kolkata presents some basic insights into India's export and import trade patterns with respect to selected set of commodities identified each week in order to facilitate preliminary commodity group/sector specific analysis for informed trade decision making.
- 2. For both categories of trade, one commodity group each is chosen from the entire ITC-HS 4-digit Classification (latest being 2024-25 classification system). The Indian Trade Classification based on Harmonized System has been adopted in India for export and import operations. While India specific data are sourced from DGCI&S, M/o C & I database, global export-import data of exactly those sets of commodities are sourced from UN-COMTRADE database.
- 3. With regards to this time-period, this report outlines trade statistics over a period of four years, i.e., 2021-22 to 2024-25. The latest finalized data available on the UN Comtrade database are only up to year 2024 (Calendar Year) and on the DGCI&S database up to April, 2025. So, for each commodity group dealt with in this report, trends from 2021 to 2024 have been showcased where data have been sourced from UN Comtrade and from 2021-22 to 2024-25 when sourced from DGCI&S database.
- 4. In this report [3rd weekly Commodity EXIM Report of July, 2025 dated 16th July, 2025] the following two commodities have been dealt with:

Export: Medicaments [ITCHS Code – 3004] - In financial year 2024-25 (April, 2024–March, 2025) this commodity group had 5.03% share in India's total export value basket as per DGCI&S database. India had occupied the 2nd slot in export of this commodity (20623.11 million USD) with 4.47% share of total global export in the year 2024.

Import: Petroleum Gases and Other Gaseous Hydrocarbons [ITCHS Code – 2711] – In financial year 2024-25 this commodity group had share of 4.10% in India's total import value basket as per DGCI&S database. India having 6.86% share of total global import of this commodity (29769.97 million USD) occupied the 4th slot in the world in 2024.

EXPORT

Medicaments classified as H.S. Code – 3004 falls under Chapter -30 (Pharmaceutical products) of Section VI (Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries) of ITC-HS classification. India is engaged in the process of exporting this commodity and in 2024-25 financial year this commodity group has so far had 5.03% share in India's total export value basket as per DGCI&S database.



Medicaments export reached over USD 22025.99 million in financial year 2024-25, marking an increase of over 12.19% compared to nearly USD 19631.19 million in financial year 2023-24. USA,


has been the top destination for Indian medicaments for years. The country receives 43.09%_of India's total export, valued at USD 9491.90 million in financial year 2024-25. The UK comes next at 2nd slot, importing USD 745.10 million worth of Medicaments from India in 2024-25 which is significant at it comprises 3.38% share of India's total export of the commodity, followed by South Africa (USD 611.19 million) bearing share of 2.77% of India's total export. For, the period under review, export of this segment was at USD 17083.39 million in 2021-22 followed by continuous rise till 2024-25.



World's 10 leading exporters of Medicaments by percentage share in 2024:


The export of Medicaments worldwide stood at USD 461505.40 million in 2024 registering a 3.90% increase as compared to the year 2023 when trade was USD 444188.1 million. Germany is the world's largest exporter of Medicaments, with USD 67745.18 million exported in 2024 accounting 14.68% share globally, followed closely by Switzerland (USD 49674.58 million) and Italy (USD 39915.15 million) with 10.76% and 8.65% shares respectively. **India** (exporting goods worth a total of USD 20623.11 million in this category) with 4.47% share, stood at 10th slot of world export of Medicaments in 2024. The value of global export of Medicaments was USD 411389.7 million in 2021 and after that it has continuously increased till 2024.



Top 10 importers of Medicaments globally from 2021 to 2024




World's 10 leading importers of Medicaments by percentage share in 2024




In 2024, global import of medicaments reached USD 458605.7 million, marking a 1.51% decrease compared to the previous year. Over the period under review, global import was at record high at USD 465652.2 million in 2023. The world's 3 biggest importers of Medicaments are the USA (20.64%), Switzerland (10.37%), and Germany (7.42%). Collectively, those 3 leading importers paid for 38.43% of globally imported Medicaments during the year 2024. **India** with only 0.26% share in this category, Stood at 45th position globally. Global import in this segment had upward trend till 2023 and then dipped a little in 2024.

As per UN Comtrade database the top 3 importers of Medicaments globally were **USA**, **Switzerland and Germany**. These 3 countries had imported 12.93%, 0.10% and 1.71% shares of their respective total import of this commodity from India in 2024.


i) Top 3 supplier nations of Medicaments to USA in 2024 (percentage share)

IMPORT

Petroleum Gases and Other Gaseous Hydrocarbons comes under Chapter 27 (Mineral fuels, mineral oils and products of their distillation; bituminous substances; mineral waxes) of Section V (Mineral Products) of ITC-HS classification.

India is engaged in the process of importing this commodity and in 2024-25 financial year this commodity group has so far had 4.10% share in India's total import value basket as per DGCI&S database.

In 2024-25, India's dependence on imported petroleum gas and other gaseous hydrocarbons increased by 17.39% as compared to the previous year. In 2024-25 India's import bill for Petroleum Gases and other Gaseous Hydrocarbons was USD 29585.64 million. As per available data, Qatar stood out as India's top exporting partner in this segment with a share of 32.47%. UAE came 2nd immediately followed by USA with shares of 26.83% and 8.60% respectively. India's import value in this segment had jumped significantly in 2022-23 from 2021-22, dipped starkly in 2023-24 and again increased in 2024-25.

Worldwide import of Petroleum Gases and Other Gaseous Hydrocarbons totalled to USD 434012.64 million in 2024 recording a 22.28% decrease over 2023 when the trade value was USD 558433.08 million. China imported USD 88063.24 million worth of the commodity in 2024, making it the leading importer of the commodity worldwide with 20.29% share of world import. Japan (10.88%) and Rep. of Korea (7.99%) lined up in second and third places in 2024. The import value of Petroleum Gases and Other Gaseous Hydrocarbons by **India** amounted to approximately USD 29769.97 million in the year 2024 and ranked 4th in the world with the share of 6.86% of total global import value of goods in this segment experiencing a big leap from USD 24860.03 million in 2023.
