A. GENERAL

1.0 SCOPE OF TENDER

The Executive Engineer, KNNL, GRBCC Div No-3, Gokak (Referred to as Employer in these documents) invites tenders following Two Cover tender procedure, from eligible Tenderers, for the construction of works (as defined in these documents and referred to as "the works") detailed in the Table given in the Invitation for Tenders (IFT). The Tenderers may submit tenders of the works detailed in the table given in IFT.

2.0 ELIGIBLE TENDERERS

Tenderers shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by the Government of Karnataka.

3.0 QUALIFICATION OF THE TENDERER:

3.1 All Tenderers shall provide the requested information accurately and sufficient detail in Section 3 : Qualification information

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA: (FOR INDIVIDUAL BIDDERS / JOINT VENTURE BIDDING).

(A)	Eligibility Criteria:

4. The annual turnover from all classes of civil engineering works should be costing not less than **Rs.16939 Lakhs**, in any of the two financial years during the last five years (i.e., 2019-20 to 2023-24). Audited profit and loss account certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant along with the copy of income tax returns filed for the years indicated above should be furnished. Duly mentioning UDIN on Turnover certificate (from CA). (The annual turnover of previous year shall be updated to the year of tender invitation at 10% per annum).

5. Liquid asset and/or availability of credit facilities of not less than **Rs.3176.00 Lakhs**(unconditional credit lines/letters of credits/certificates from nationalized/scheduled banks) for meeting the fund requirement etc. The contractor should upload necessary documents issued by then nationalized/scheduled/commercial banks as per prescribed format enclosed as Annexure-XIV. Further the agency has to furnish the above credit facilities for the entire work period as per tender.

6. The intending bidder should have executed in any one year, the following minimum quantities of work (usually 80% of the peak annual rate of construction) during the last 5 years (i.e from 2019-20 to 2023-24). The necessary work done certificate issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer of the respective Division and counter signed by the Superintending Engineer of the the same circle should be uploaded.

Note:-1: The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Employer in- charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or Equivalent.

Note:-2: Even though the Tenderers meet the above criteria they are subject to be disqualified if they have made misleading or false representation in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements.

- 3.2 Each Tenderer should further demonstrate:** Availability, by owning 50% of the required/specified following key and critical equipment for this work and the remaining 50% can be deployed on lease/hire basis for all works provided. The relevant documents (Commitment agreements etc.) for availability are to be furnished (Documents to be scanned and enclosed). The intending bidder/firm/company/Joint venture should furnish details of ownership/ lease certificate of the following minimum requirement of equipment.

- 3.3 IN THE CASE OF THE DEATH OF THE CONTRACTOR AFTER EXECUTING THE AGREEMENT / COMMENCEMENT OF THE WORK BY LEGAL HEIR, IF IS AN ELIGIBLE REGISTERED CONTRACTOR AND IS WILLING CAN EXECUTE AND COMPLETE THE WORK AT ACCEPTED TENDER RATES IRRESPECTIVE OF THE COST OF THE WORK.
- 3.4 NECESSARY WORK EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATE OF LEGAL HEIR ISSUED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY NOT BELOW THE RANK OF EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, INDICATING THE NAME/ITEMS OF WORK EXECUTED, DATE OF COMMENCEMENT, DATE OF COMPLETION AND THE TOTAL COST OF WORK EXECUTED SHALL BE ENCLOSED TO THE TENDER. TENDERS WITHOUT THESE DETAILS ARE LIABLE FOR DISQUALIFICATION.
- 3.5 TO QUALIFY FOR A PACKAGE OF CONTRACTS (MORE THAN ONE) MADE UP OF THIS AND OTHER CONTRACTS FOR WHICH TENDERS ARE INVITED IN THIS IFT, THE TENDERER MUST DEMONSTRATE HAVING EXPERIENCE AND RESOURCES TO MEET THE AGGREGATE OF THE QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR ALL THE CONTRACTS.
- 3.6 Each bidder should furnish liquid assets and/or availability of credit facilities of not less than **Rs.3176.00 Lakhs** from any Nationalised bank [Credit lines / letter of credit / certificates from banks for meeting the fund requirement etc. (Usually the equivalent of the estimated cash flow for 3 months in

the peak construction period)]Format prescribed in respect of obtaining the Bank Certificate/Line of Credit:

Cover-II (Financial Bid): shall contain lumpsum Turnkey amount with detailed breakup of amount quoted. The Electronic Document (Technical bid) will be opened first and there after Second Electronic Document (financial bid) will be opened only of those bidders who qualify in the technical bid. In case the lowest bidder fails to produce the original documents for entering into an agreement or the original documents submitted does not match with the uploaded documents or found false, then his bid is treated as non-responsive bid as per clause-26 (4) of the KTPP rules & his name would be removed from the selected list of KPWD enrolment and barred from participation in any of the tenders invited by the KNNL apart from forfeiting the EMD paid through E-cash.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The bid shall be technically evaluated based on the specifications indicated in Section-6 titled “Contract Data and Scope of work” in bid document.
2. The Bidder/ JV partner shall not be under **Corporate Debt Restructuring (CDR)** / Strategic Debt Restructuring (SDR) or Bureau of Industrial and Financial Reconstruction (BIFR) in the last 5 Years prior to bid submission date. In this regard, the Bidder shall submit along with Bid, a certificate from their Statutory Auditor with a declaration that, the Bidder is not under CDR / SDR or BIFR.
3. During technical evaluation, if the employer finds that any certificates / information furnished is false, such bidders will be disqualified and barred from participation in the bid.
4. If any bidder fails to satisfy the conditions mentioned above, such bids will be rejected and their financial bids will not be opened.
5. For laying M.S and HDPE pipeline the contractor shall engage only those agencies who have done similar job.
6. The bidder should enclose the detailed methodology of execution of the scheme as per the scope of work.
7. The Bidder /JV partner shall be responsible for successful performance of the contract.
8. The Bidder to participate in the tender under single bid basis only. Any violation will attract disqualification of the bid.
9. The contractor / authorized signatory should attach his / her scanned signature to the Schedule-B before uploading and also submitting their tenders.
10. If any of the dates mentioned above happen to be a general holiday, the next working day holds good.
11. As per MD Circular 0645 dated 02/06/2020, there is no Mobilization advance payment.

12. The diameter and thickness for the MS pipeline work, the dia, material grade and pressure rating for HDPE pipeline work shall not be less than the figures indicated in the enclosed schematic diagram. Further any discrepancies in the above shall not account to financial implications to the employer.

14. **Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected.**
15. The officer competent to accept the tender shall have the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason what so ever.
16. **Corrigendum / Addendum will be published in the KPP website only. No newspapers publications.**
17. The intending bidders should note that, if any of lands either in part / parts or in whole required for the work is not acquired by the Nigam, it shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder to take the possession of such land and start the work by obtaining consent of the land owners before commencement of work at no extra cost to the Nigam and no claim/ delays what so ever relating to on account of non-availability of land would be entertained.
18. If the percentage quoted by the contractor for the work is below ninety percent of the updated recast estimated amount put to tender, then the contractor shall furnish an “additional performance security” in the form of Bank Guarantee for an amount equivalent to the difference between the cost as per quoted percentage and 90% of the updated cost put to tender. In case of contractor quoting above 125% of updated cost put to tender, then the over and above 125% of the updated cost put to tender will be withheld during the progress of work. The additional performance will be released proportionately to the bill amount till the contractor achieves progress of the entire cost of the work as per agreement. The withheld amount in the later case will be released only after the entire work contracted is fully completed and so certified by the Executive Engineer. (If BG submitted while issuing fresh BG or extending any existing BG, claim period of a minimum one year from the date of expiry of validity period of BG is to be specified invariably)

20. The agency shall establish his own equipped quality control filed laboratory.
21. The intending bidders are advised to visit the site of work, make themselves familiar with local situation about the availability of construction materials, workmen, land required for construction activities, etc..
22. The contractor is responsible for any damages due to natural calamity. The government or Nigam will not give any compensation until the completion of the maintenance period..
23. Royalty recovery in the Running Bills will be done as per MDP Circular dated 15/03/2024.
24. SD (Security Deposit) in terms of e-bank guarantee circular 0599 dated 18.05.2024.

25. The contractor should mention their recent correct postal / portal address & mail address in declaration forms.

27. All materials like steel, cement, MS pipe, HDPE pipe, etc., required for successful completion of the above work should be procured by the contractor only. No supply of any materials shall be made by KNNL.
28. The bidder/firm/company shall send the authorization letter for their representation, duly attesting their signature
29. Maintenance period/Defect liability period for this work is **60 months** from the date of completion of work.
30. The bidder shall note that design parameters of Stage-II depends on the finalisation of designs of Stage-I. Hence the bidder shall note and co-ordinate with Stage-I works and contractor.
31. The bidder/firm/company shall adhere to the accepted execution plan submitted by him under any circumstances without linking to the pending payment of the work & also land acquisition problems, if any.
