COUNTRY PROFILE REPORT OF ITJ DIVISION, DGCI&S DATED 20-03-2024 INDIA-FRANCE BILATERAL TRADE RELATIONS

INTRODUCTION & BRIEF ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

The French Republic is situated in Western Europe. It is bounded to the north by the English Channel (la Manche), to the east by Belgium, Luxembourg, Germany, Switzerland and Italy, to the south by Mediterranean Sea and Spain, and to the west by the Atlantic Ocean. France is a member of the UN, the Council of Europe, NATO, WEU, EU, OSCE, OECD and the Pacific Community and is signatory to the Schengen Accord. This report emphasises on India-France trade relations, inter-alia. As per available data from DGCI&S database India and France have observable bilateral (goods) trade relations primarily in the form of India's exports to and imports from France. There has been observable positive incremental change in India's export to France in recent years of 2021-22 and 2022-23.

2. France has a mixed market economy, characterised by sizeable government involvement, and economic diversity. For roughly two centuries, the French economy has consistently ranked among the ten largest economic globally. France has historically been one of the world's major agricultural centres and remains a "global agricultural powerhouse". As per available report of IMF Executive Board Concludes 2022 Article IV Consultation with France January 30, 2023, France saw a robust recovery from the Covid-19 shock but later faced the repercussions of Russia's war in Ukraine. In 2021, output rebounded by 6.8 percent and recovered to pre-crisis levels. The recovery was broadbased and faster than in most other European countries. As per European forecast for France, in 2024 GDP of France is expected to grow moderately by 0.9% annually. Net exports are set to have limited contrition to growth with strong exports growth offset by rising imports as domestic demand expends.

.FOREIGN TRADE

3. As per recent available inputs on WITS (World Integrated Trade Solution), the five major merchandise export partners of France are Germany, Italy, Belgium, Spain and United States. On the other hand five major import partners of Brazil France are Germany, Belgium, Netherlands, Italy and Spain. Major five exported goods of France are (i) Aircraft nes of an unladen weight exceeding 15 (ii) Other medicaments of mixed or unmixed products (iii) Beauty, make-up, skin-care (incl. suntan), nes (iv) Wine (not sparkling); grape must with by alcohol and (v) Turbo-jets of a thrust exceeding 25 KN. On the other hand major five imported goods of France are (i) Petroleum oils, etc, (excl. crude); preparation, (ii) Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous, (iii) Other medicaments of mixed or unmixed products, (iv) Transmission apparatus, for radioteleph incorpo and (v) Natural gas in gaseous stat.

4. France's total exports to the world in 2018 were of the order of US\$ 568,536 million. It has scaled upto US\$ 618,299 million in 2022. Exports from France had steeply increased by 19.96% over 2020 followed by 5.62% rise in 2022. During the period from 2018 to 2022, the annual average compound rate of growth of exports was 2.12%.

5. France's total imports in 2018 were of the order of US\$ 659,375 million and which had touched US\$ 819,398 million mark in 2022 with a 23.25% jump in the year 2021 over 2020 followed by 14.46 rise in 2022 over 2021. During the period from 2018 to 2022, the annual average compound rate of growth of Imports was 5.58%.

6. France runs an overall Balance of Trade deficit from 2018 to 2022 and that has scaled upto USD - 201,099 million in 2022. During the period from 2018 to 2022, the annual average compound rate of growth of total volume of trade was 4.02%.

A snapshot of France's overall Trade Statistics is presented in Table 1 and Figure 1 below.



BILATERAL TRADE WITH INDIA

Merchandise Trade

7. India and France have important bilateral investment ties and trade and commercial cooperation. Both countries have maintained significant relations in various sectors and are working towards achieving new heights in trade and economic relations. France ranked 19th as an export destination with France in FY 2022-23. Well as 1.68 % of India's total export value in FY2022-23. In the same financial year imports from France was 0.86% of India's total import value. France ranked 27th as import partner of India in FY 2022-23.

8. Indo-France total volume of bilateral trade in FY 2018-19 was of the order of US\$ 11,901.06 million. It has scaled upto US\$ 13,812.99 million in FY 2022-23. The annual compound growth rate of total volume of trade during the period from 2018-19 to 2022-23 has been of the order of 3.79% and the trade balance (surplus) position has favoured India highlighting export dynamics between the two nations.

9. Exports from India to France increased steeply by 38.81% in FY2021-22 followed by another 14.57% increase in FY 2022-23. The annual average compound rate of growth of Exports was 9.81%. On the other hand, imports from France to India increased by 33.13% in FY 2021-22 followed by 7.25% rise in 2022-23. During the period from 2018-19 to 2022-23, the annual average compound rate of growth of imports was -1.79% due to substantial decline in 2020-21.

A snapshot of India's merchandise trade statistics w.r.t. France is presented in Table 2 Figure 2.



10. Additionally, **from Tables 3 & 4 presented** below the following are stated:

a. **Petroleum Products, Electric Machinery and Equipments** and **Drugs Formulations, Biologicals** have occupied the top three slots in India's exports to France in the year 2022-23. Petroleum Products has occupied the 16.97% share of export value India to France.

b. Aircraft, Spacecraft and Parts, Electric Machinery and Equipments and Petroleum Products are the three major commodities in India's imported list from France in the year 2022-23, India imported Aircraft, Spacecraft and Parts, from France with a share of 35.25% of total imports from France recorded in 2022-23.
