Commodity EXIM Report

1. The weekly EXIM Report published by ITJ Division of DGCI&S, Kolkata presents some basic insights into India's export and import trade patterns with respect to selected set of commodities identified each week in order to facilitate preliminary commodity group/sector specific analysis for informed trade decision making.
2. For both categories of trades, one commodity group is chosen from the entire ITC-HS 4-digit Classification (latest being 2024 classification system). The Indian Trade Classification based on Harmonized System has been adopted in India for Export and Import Operations. While India specific data is sourced from DGCI&S, M/o C&I Database, global export-import data of exactly those sets of commodities are sourced from UN-COMTRADE Database.
3. As regards the time-period, this report outlines trade statistics over a period of four years, i.e., 2021 to 2024. The latest finalized data available on the UN Comtrade Database is only up to year 2024 (Calendar Year) and on the DGCI&S Database up to October, 2025. So, for each commodity group dealt in this report, trends from 2021 to 2024 have been showcased where data has been sourced from UN Comtrade and from DGCI&S database.
4. In the instant report [3rd weekly Commodity Exim Report of December, 2025 dated 17th December, 2025] the following two commodities have been dealt with.

Export : New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber [ITCHS Code –4011] - In the year 2024 this commodity group had 0.67% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S database. India occupied the 8th slot in export of this commodity (2924 million USD) with 3.04% share of total global exports in the year 2024.

Import : Mineral or Chemical Fertilisers Containing Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium; Other Fertilisers [ITCHS Code – 3105] –In the year 2024 this commodity group had share of 0.54% in India's total Import value basket as per DGCI&S database. India having 12.14% share of total global imports of this commodity (3843.33 million USD) occupied the 2nd slot in the world in 2024.

EXPORT

New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber classified as H.S. Code – 4011 falls under Chapter -40 (Rubber and articles thereof) of Section-VII (Plastics and Articles Thereof; Rubber and Articles thereof) of ITC-HS classification.

India is engaged in the process of exporting this commodity and in 2024 this commodity group had 0.67% share in India's total Export value basket as per DGCI&S database.



India's top 10 destinations of New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber by percentage share in 2024




New pneumatic Tyres exports from India made a sharp recovery in the year 2024 (USD 2972.85 million), increased by 11.70% in value terms compared to the previous year when the export value in this segment was USD 2661.48 million. In value terms, USA (USD 509.10 million) remains the key foreign market for tyres exports from India in 2024, comprising 17.12% of total exports from India in this segment. The second position in the ranking was held by Germany (USD 172.65 million), with a 5.81% share of total exports followed by Brazil (USD 159.51 million), with a 5.37% share. The trend pattern indicated some noticeable fluctuations throughout the observable period.



World's 10 leading exporters of New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber (percentage share in 2024):




In 2024, global trade of this commodity was USD 96031.65 million, reflecting a 2.76% decrease from 2023, when trade totalled was USD 98762.18 million. Over the period under review, global exports in this segment increased till 2023 and then declined in 2024. Over the period under review, the market attained the maximum level at USD 98762.18 million in 2023. **India** exported USD 2924 million with 3.04% share of the global exports in this segment in 2024 and stood at 8th slot in the world. Global exports of new pneumatic tires in 2024 were led by China (USD 22246.62 million), followed by Thailand (USD 7397.13 million) and Germany (USD 5644.88 million) with the 23.17%, 7.70% and 5.88% share globally in 2024.



Top 10 importers of New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber from 2021 to 2024 (Data labels signified for 2024)




World's 10 leading importers of New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber (percentage share in 2024)




The imports of New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber worldwide was USD 93013.50 million in 2024, declined by 1.15 % from 2023 levels. The lead importers in this segment in 2024 were USA (21.46%), Germany (8.47%) and France (5.31%). **India** with a share of only 0.23% in this category, stood at 57th position globally. Global imports in this segment increased in 2022 and then turned to decrease till 2024.

As per UN Comtrade database the top 3 importers of New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber worldwide, were **USA, Germany and France**. USA, Germany and France imported 2.76%, 2.27% and 2.70% share respectively of their total import of this commodity from India in 2024 which are presented below :


(i) Top 3 supplier nations of New Pneumatic Tyres, of Rubber to USA in 2024

IMPORT

Mineral or Chemical Fertilisers Containing Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium; Other Fertilisers classified as H.S. Code – 3105 falls under Chapter -31(Fertilisers) of Section VI (Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries) of ITC-HS Classification.

India is engaged in the process of importing this commodity and in the year 2024 this commodity group had share of 0.54% in India's total Import value basket as per DGCI&S database.

India imported a total of USD 3894.92 million worth of Mineral or Chemical Fertilisers Containing Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium; Other Fertilisers, declined by 25.27% compared to the year 2023. As per available data, Saudi Arabia stood as India's top importing partner in this segment with a share of 31.29%. Next in line comes Morocco and Russia with shares of 19.62% and 18.65% respectively. India's import value in this segment increased to USD 8022.77 million in 2022 over USD 3764.44 million in 2021, then decreased till 2024.

Worldwide import of Mineral or Chemical Fertilisers Containing Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium; Other Fertilisers only totalled to USD 31659.57 million in 2024 declined by almost 4% over 2023 levels. **India** imported USD 3843.33 million worth of the commodity in 2024, making it the 2nd leading importer of the commodity group worldwide with 12.14% share of world imports followed by USA (6%). The lead importer in this segment consistently been Brazil (14.96%). Over the period under review the global import value of Mineral or Chemical Fertilisers Containing Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium; Other Fertilisers had a huge jump in 2022 over 2021 levels and then declined till 2024.
