

Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration
2. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 - 1.The bidders are instructed to read the uploaded scope of work/tender document carefully and submit the bid accordingly.
 - 2.The bidder will submit all documents in the specified format,if any, as asked in the uploaded scope of work/tender document.
 - 3.The condition of having servicing outlet in West Bengal is necessary condition of this tender. If any bidder fails to meet that condition at the time of bidding the bidder may participate in the bidding process with the undertaking that the bidder will establish a servicing outlet in West Bengal if the contract is awarded to him/her within 30 days of awarding the contract. In failure of such, the bid/contract is liable to be rejected/cancelled.
 - 4.Attending the pre-bid meeting is necessary to understand the project completely. The technical evaluation will be conducted as per QCBS template and understanding the project is an integral part of the evaluation. The bidder may participate either by physically or virtually at pre-bid meeting as mentioned in tender document. The virtual link to join the pre-bid meeting is given as [meet.google.com/vyj-nrfr-wbp]
 - 5.The bid follows all rule and regulation mentioned in GFR and exemption if any mentioned therein.
 - 6.Evaluation will be done as per the tender document.
 7. Bank guarantee for EMD will also be considered.
 8. It is envisaged that the total number of pages will range between 2-5; however, this may change depending on developments in the scope of the survey.
 9. During warranty of maintenance there may arise scope for change request features.
 10. The licence cost for enterprise version of data base for the entire 2 years 3 months period e.g., PostgreSQL, MySQL etc. has to be borne by the bidder. But the subscription has to be in the name of DGCI&S.
 11. During AMC, database and application related maintenance has to be taken care of by the bidder.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
