- 3.1.10 During the time of technical evaluation, if the employer finds the any certificates / information furnished is false, such bidders will be disqualified and barred from participation

- 4.2 The contractor / authorized signatory should attach his / her scanned signature to the Schedule-B before uploading the document.
- 4.3 If any of the dates mentioned above happened to be a general holiday, the next working day holds
- 4.4 Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected. The competent authority to accept the tenders shall have the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.

- 4.6 (a) The intending bidders should note that, if any part or whole of land required for the work is not yet acquired by the KBJNL it shall be the responsibility of the contractor to procure possession of such land by consent by the land owner before commencement of work at no extra cost to KBJNL and no claim whatsoever relating to non-availability of land would be entertained.
  - (b) The contractor should note that, the land required for the work shall be at his personal responsibility till the completion of work.
- 4.7 The intending bidder should note that, as the tender invited is on percentage basis, if the bid amount based on the percentage quoted by the contractor is less than the amount put to tender, the contractor shall submit the additional performance security for an amount equal to the difference between the amount put to tender and quoted amount in the form of FDR as per security deposit clause mentioned in the tender document. In case of contractor quotes the rates above 110% of the estimated rates, then the amount over and above 110% will be withheld during the progress of work. The additional performance security will be released proportionately to the bill amount till the contractor achieves progress of entire work as per agreement.
- 4.8 Within 20days of receipt of the letter of acceptance, The successful tenderer shall deliver to the employer a security deposit in any of the forms given below for an amount equivalent to 5% of the contract price plus additional performance security deposit for an amount equivalent to difference between quoted amount and estimated amount put to tender for Unbalanced tenders.
