Commodity EXIM Report DGCI&S, ITJ Division

- 1. The weekly EXIM report published by ITJ Division of DGCI&S, Kolkata presents some basic insights into India's export and import trade patterns with respect to selected set of commodities identified each week in order to facilitate preliminary commodity group/sector specific analysis for informed decision making regarding trade.
- 2. For both categories of trade, one commodity group each is chosen from the entire ITC-HS 4-digit Classification (latest being 2023-2024 classification system). The Indian Trade Classification based on Harmonized System has been adopted in India for export and import operations. While India specific data are sourced from DGCI&S, M/o Commerce & Industry database, global export-import data of exactly those sets of commodities are sourced from UN-COMTRDADE database.
- 3. Considering the time-period, this report outlines trade statistics for over a period of four years, i.e., 2020-2021 to 2023-2024. The latest finalized data available on the UN Comtrade database is only up to year 2023 (Calendar Year) and on the DGCI&S database up to February, 2025. So, for each commodity group dealt with in this report, trends from 2020 to 2023 have been showcased where data have been sourced from UN Comtrade and from 2020-2021 to 2023-2024 when sourced from DGCI&S database.
- 4. In this report [4th weekly Commodity EXIM Report of May, 2025 dated 28th May, 2025] the following two commodities have been dealt with:-

Export: Tea, Whether or Not Flavoured [ITCHS Code – 0902] – In financial year 2023-24 (April, 2023–March, 2024) this commodity group had 0.17% share in India's total export value basket as per DGCI&S database. India had occupied the 4th slot in export of this commodity (706.90 million USD) with 9.09% share of total global export in the year 2023-24.

Import: Artificial Corundum, Whether or not Chemically Defined; Aluminium Oxide; Aluminium Hydroxide[ITCHS Code – 2818] – In financial year 2023-24 (April 2023 – March,2024) this commodity group had a share of 0.16% in India's total import value basket as per DGCI&S database. India having 6.82% share of total global import of this commodity (1080.96 million USD) occupied the 4th slot in the world in 2023.

EXPORT

Tea, Whether or not Flavoured classified as H.S. Code – 0902 falls under Chapter -09 (Coffee, tea, mate and spices) of Section-II (Vegetable Products) of ITC-HS classification.

India is engaged in the process of exporting this commodity and in 2023-24 financial year this commodity group had so far had 0.17% share in India's total export value basket as per DGCI&S database.



India's top 10 destinations of Tea, Whether or Not Flavoured by percentage share in 2023-24




India's tea export surged to USD 743.05 million in 2023-24, reflecting a little increase of 0.36% from the previous year's figure of USD 740.40 million. India's top tea export partners include the UAE, Iraq, and Russia. These countries represent a significant portion of India's total tea export. UAE (USD 122.89 million) had held the topmost slot of export destinations of this segment from India with 16.54% share of India's total export of tea. In 2nd and 3rd place were Iraq (USD 87.95 million) and Russia (USD 77.14 million) to where India exported around 11.84% and 10.38% shares of tea respectively in 2023-24. For, the period under review, tea export was at USD 700.41 million in 2020-21 followed by a moderate dip in 2021-22 and then continued to rise till 2023-24.



The overall tea export had a total value of USD 7775.98 million in 2023 reflecting a 7.87% decrease from 2022, when trade totaled USD 8440.19 million. Over the period under review, global export of tea had increased in 2021 and after that it had continuously declined till 2023. India with export value of USD 706.90 million accounted for 9.09% share of global tea export in 2023 and stood at 4th slot in the world. The lead exporter in this segment had consistently been China (USD 1739.20 million) with


a share of 22.37% in 2023, followed by Kenya (USD 1345.98 million) and Sri Lanka (USD 1289.91 million) with 17.31% and 16.59% shares respectively of world export.



Top 10 importers of Tea, Whether or Not Flavoured from 2020 to 2023




World's 10 leading importers of Tea, Whether or Not Flavoured (percentage share in 2023)




Tea import worldwide was USD 5519.33 million in 2023, reflecting a decline of 14.35 % from 2022 when the import value of tea was USD 6443.96 million globally. The lead importers in this segment in 2023 had been Pakistan (10.65%), USA (9.42%) and UK (5.62%). **India** with only 0.83% share in this category, stood at 30th position globally. Global import in this segment had steadily increased till 2021 and then turned down till 2023 experiencing a major dip in 2023.

As per UN Comtrade database the top 3 importers of Tea, Whether or not Flavoured in 2023 were **Pakistan, USA and UK**. Out of these three countries Pakistan had no trade in this segment with India. USA and UK had imported 10.83% and 14.38% shares of their respective total imports of tea from India in 2023 which are presented below:

IMPORT

Artificial Corundum, Whether or Not Chemically Defined; Aluminium Oxide; Aluminium Hydroxide classified as ITCHS Code – 2818 falls under Chapter -28 (Inorganic chemicals, organic or inorganic compounds of precious metals, of rare-earth metals, of radioactive elements or of isotopes) of Section–VI (Products of the chemical or allied industries) of ITC-HS Classification.

India is engaged in the process of importing this commodity and in the financial year 2023-24 this commodity group had share of 0.16% in India's total import value basket as per DGCI&S database.

In 2023-24 India had imported a total of USD 1067.64 million worth of Artificial Corundum, Whether or not Chemically Defined; Aluminium Oxide; Aluminium Hydroxide, experiencing a decrease of 9.40% compared to 2022-23. As per available data, Indonesia stood out as India's top importing partner in this segment with a share of 40.63%. Next in line came Australia and Vietnam with shares of 23.50% and 14.47% respectively. India's import value in this segment had been steadily increasing from USD 806.89 million in 2020-21 to USD 1178.36 million in 2022-23, experiencing a major leap in 2021-22 and then dipped in 2023-24.

Worldwide import of Artificial Corundum, Whether or not Chemically Defined; Aluminium Oxide; Aluminium Hydroxide only totaled to USD 15850.68 million in 2023 recording a decline of 14.11% from 2022. Canada imported USD 1749.09 million worth of the commodity in 2023, making it the lead importer worldwide with 11.04% share of world import. Bahrain (7.52%) and UAE (7.30%) lined up in second and third places in 2023. The import value of Artificial Corundum, Whether or not Chemically Defined; Aluminium Oxide; Aluminium Hydroxide by **India** amounted to approximately USD 1080.96 million in the year 2023 and **India** ranked 4th in the world with the share of 6.82% of total global import value of goods in this segment.
