The proposed methodology and program of construction, backed with equipment planning and deployment, duly supported with broad calculation and quality control procedures proposed to be adopted, justifying their capability of execution and completion of the work as per technical specification within the stipulated period of completion as per milestones.
- 1.14 In view of introduction of GST from 01.07.2017, in the NIT and Bid Document, the following stipulation shall be incorporated:
