## **TENDER NOTIFICATION** **(Through KPP Portal only)** **Two Cover System**

The Executive Engineer, VJNL, Upper Bhadra Project, Division No.05, Chitradurga, Karnataka invites **Turnkey Tenders** On behalf of the Managing Director, Visvesvaraya Jala Nigama Limited, Bangalore from eligible tenderers for the works detailed in the table below. The tenderers may submit tenders for the work given in the table through Karnataka Public Procurement Portal (KPP portal) <https://kppp.karnataka.gov.in>. The two cover electronic tender procedure as per Rule 28 of KTPP Act shall be followed. Tenderer are required to submit two separate Covers, 1<sup>st</sup> Cover (Technical Bid) containing EMD with technical details of their capability to undertake the tender (as detailed in ITT Clause 3 and 6) which will be opened first and the second cover containing the price tender which will be opened only if the tenderers are found to be qualified to execute the tendered work. The tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria statement specified in Clause 3 of the Instructions to tenderers to qualify for award of the contract.

- Tenders must be accompanied by earnest money deposit which will be paid online through KPP Portal.
- Tenderers must submit Electronic Tender Documents One and Two electronically (on-line through internet) within the date and time published in KPP Portal.

## MODE OF PAYMENT

### Tender Transaction Fee and EMD

The contractor can request for e-tendering documents in the web site [www.kppp.karnataka.gov.in](http://www.kppp.karnataka.gov.in) link and contractor can pay the transaction fee in the KPP portal using following payment modes on or before below mentioned date.

Each tenderer must pay specified full Earnest money Deposit (EMD) in the e-proc platform only through following payment modes.

### Mode of payment in the KPP portal

- Direct Debit
- National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT)
- Over the Counter (OTC)
- e-BG

The validity of EMD shall be for a period of 225 days from the stipulated date of opening of the Tender.

**2. Electronic Document –I (TECHNICAL BID) SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS: -**

- i) Valid KPWD/CPWD Class-I registration certificate.
- ii) The requisite Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in e- cash/e-BG.
- iii) Copy of the PAN card with GSTIN
- iv) Valid Employees Provident Fund Registration Certificate along with latest paid challan copy.
- v) Income Tax returns of last 5 years.
- vi) The details of Joint Venture along with agreements in this regard are to be uploaded.
- vii) Scanned signature of the bidder / authorized representative in case of a firm or company, to be attached while uploading the bid documents. Also in case of authorized representative, scanned copy of power of attorney should be uploaded.
- viii) Tenders from a Tie-up proposed in this bid, the bidder shall upload an agreement with only one pump manufacturer on Rs. 500-00 stamp paper in the prescribed format which shall be concluded prior to bidding and enclosed to the bid document. For proof of the Tie up, in the Technical bid, the prescribed format under section 2 - instruction to bidder shall be followed multiple tie up not allowed
- ix) The intending bidder can submit bids as an Individual/ Joint Venture bidder along with Tie up of pump manufacturer. The Tie up is to be formed prior to the bidding. In case of Joint Venture bidding the lead partner should have at least 51 percent partnership

**Joint ventures:**

Joint venture is acceptable.

**The intending bidder can submit bids as an Individual/ Joint Venture bidder along with Tie-up of pump manufacturer. The Tie -up is to be formed prior to the bidding. In case of Joint Venture bidding, the lead partner should have at least 51% partnership.**

Tenders from a Tie-up proposed in this bid, the bidder shall upload an agreement with only one pump manufacturer on Rs. 500-00 stamp paper in the prescribed format which shall be concluded prior to bidding and enclosed to the bid document. For proof of the Tie up, in the Technical bid, the prescribed format under section 2 - instruction to bidder shall be followed (multiple tie -up not allowed).

The bidder /JV partner/Pump Tie up partner shall not be under Corporate Debt Restructuring

(CDR) / Strategic Debt Restructuring (SDR) or Bureau of Industrial and Financial Reconstruction (BIFR) in the last 5 years prior to bid submission date.

### **3. Qualification of the Tenderer:**

#### **Electronic Document – II SHALL CONTAIN THE FINANCIAL BID:-**

The Cover – I (Technical bid) will be opened first and thereafter Cover-II (Financial bid) will be opened only for those bidders who qualifies the technical bid and the date of opening of financial bid of the qualified bidders will be intimated. The financial bid documents for the above work comprises of financial bid to indicate the amount offered by the bidder for completion of the above work on “Turnkey basis” based on scope of work.

#### **Notes:**

- 1 Joint venture is acceptable.
- 2 Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State Government / Government of India /Union Territory.
- 3 It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure credit of Tender Processing Fee and EMD into the respective receiving bank accounts of KPP on or before the last date and time of bid submission.
- 4 The bidder is required to ensure browser compatibility of the computer well in advance to the last date and time for receipt of tenders. The departments shall not be responsible for non-accessibility of KPP Portal due to internet connectivity issues and technical glitches at bidder's end.
- 5 The tender documents shall require all tenderes to pay an EMD at the rates as per the Department rules by means of a demand draft, banker's cheque, specified small savings instruments or where the procuring entity deems fit, irrevocable bank guarantee in a specified form of the Department including e-Bank guarantee in the name of Executive Engineer, VJNL, UBP Division No. 5, Chitradurga / e-Payment, insurance surety bonds issued by insurance company authorized by Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India. The contractor should furnish the copy of uploaded BG in the name of Executive Engineer, VJNL, UBP Division No. 5, Chitradurga not later than 18 /08 /2025 before 11:00 am to this office. The same will be sent for confirmation thereafter.
- 6 Bidder shall pay Contract Management Module processing fees as per KPP-Portal norms.
- 7 Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
- 8 The under signed reserves the right to either postpone or to cancel the entire process of the tender without assigning any reasons.
- 9 If VJNL wishes to engage Third party consultant for Quality control assessment, apart from the VJNL quality control and field tests, the contractor should cooperate with both quality control authorities and third party.
- 10 Defect liability period will be **12 months** from the date of satisfactory completion of work.
- 11 The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and the employer will in no case be responsible and liable for those costs.

- 12 The Tender processing fee shall not be refundable.
- 13 Royalty on construction materials and other taxes will be deducted as per prevailing Govt orders/circulars during execution of work.
- 14 All Government orders/circulars prevailing and issued from time to time related to tenders shall be applicable.
- 15 As per Karnataka state Government order LD/300/LET/2006 Bangalore dated 01.01.2007 and Government letter no PW/134/BMS/2007 dated 27.07.2007, a sum amounting to 1% of the bill amount will be deducted towards constructions labour welfare fund.
- 16 All scanned documents to be uploaded shall be in original and the Executive Engineer reserves the right to verify the documents before approval.
- 17 The employer reserves the rights to Reject or accept any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons.
- 18 The intending bidders should note that, if any of lands either in part/parts or whole required for the work is not acquired by the Nigam, it shall be the responsibility of the bidder to take possession of such land and start the work by consent of land owners and with the co-operation of the Nigam before commencement of work at no extra cost to the Nigam and no claim whatsoever relating to non-availability of land would be entertained.
- 19 In the case of the death of the contractor after executing the agreement / commencement of the work, his legal heir, if is an eligible registered contractor and willing, can execute and complete the work at the accepted tender rates irrespective of the cost of the work.
- 20 Contractor has to make his own arrangement for procurement of all materials required for the work. There is no departmental supply of materials. Contractor should procure only ISI mark materials and submit necessary quality control certificates from the authorized quality control authority, before execution.
- 21 All safety precautions, warning signs, night illumination, reflectors, deployment of security guards has to be ensured so that no untoward incident happens on account of negligence or any project activity. Contractor should indemnify the client to that extent.
- 22 Materials like steel, cement, blasting material etc., required for the work shall be procured by the tenderer themselves. The materials like steel, cement should got tested by the quality control authority before use on the work at their own cost.
- 23 The contractor's assessed available tender capacity will be calculated as per the clause 3.6 of ITT tender document attached.
- 24 All the items in the tender include all lead, lifts, loading unloading, transportation, dewatering and desilting labor, hire charges of machinery curing for concrete works, cost and conveyance of all material and all other such incidental charges necessary for successful completion of works as per the detailed technical specification and direction of Engineer in charge of this work.
- 25 All precautions should be taken by the contractor so that there are no damages to such public/private properties.
- 26 Contractor should take all precautionary measures to avoid any damage to the utilities during excavation as well as utility shifting. To that extent the contractor should indemnify the client.


- 27 Contractor should follow strictly the prevailing rules of labour act.
- 28 Further particulars, if any, required by the Contractor can be had from the office of the **Executive Engineer VJNL, UBP Division No.5, Chitradurga** during office hours on all working days.
- 29 Contractor should take all precautions to ensure that no damage is caused to the existing structures which have been constructed by other agencies/Nigam during project execution. If any damage is caused, it has to be rectified at his own risk and cost.
- 30 Amount put to tender includes cost of cement, Steel and other materials for finished item of work including labour charges and all other incidental charges for successful completion of work.
- 31 The Operation & Maintenance (O&M) will be 60 months after successful commissioning of work. Defect Liability Period (DLP) will be 12 months from the date of satisfactory completion of work.
- 32 The intending contractors are requested to note that they should abide by the detailed instructions and conditions contained in the Standard Tender documents.
- 33 The Bid validity shall be for a minimum period of 180 days from the date of submission of tenders. E.M.D. shall be valid for 45 days beyond the validity of the tender.
- 34 Contractors should be registered as KPWD/CPWD Class- 1 Civil Contractor.
- 35 If the percentage quoted by the contractor for the work is below 90% of the estimated amount put to tender or recast amount put to tender of the department, then the contractor shall furnish an additional performance security in the form of bank guarantee for an amount equivalent to the difference between the cost as per quoted percentage and 90% of the estimated amount put to tender or recast amount put to tender. In case of contractor quotes rates above 125% of the estimated rates then the amount over and above 125 % will be withheld during the progress of work. The additional performance security will be released proportionately to the bill amount till the contractor achieves progress of the entire cost of the work as per the agreement.
- 36 The necessary certificates/ documents in support fulfilling qualification criteria stipulated separately shall be scanned and attached to KPP Portal document. The original document shall be produced at the time of opening of tender/during evaluation of tender Technical Bid for verification.
- 37 The evaluation of the technical bid will be done based on the information provided by the contractor as per uploaded documents, duly verified if necessary. If the employer finds that any certificates/ information furnished is false, such bidders will be disqualified, barred from participation in the bid and his EMD will be forfeited.
- 38 Valid Employees Provident Fund Registration Certificate along with latest paid challan copy shall be uploaded.
